### You are Important and each Position on a Team is Vital!

It is important that the House of Prayer be organized, so that there is no confusion for leaders and participants. We believe God works through anointed leadership that allows freedom in the Spirit. God is the Head, and He looks to partner with us here on the earth.

### **Positions of Trust**

In the priesthood, every person had a role assigned to them to keep the sanctuary of the Lord operating smoothly 24 hours a day. The Bible refers to the sacred duties as positions that were entrusted to them. We call our prayer commitment the "Sacred Trust" because like the priests of old we want to treat our commitment to help maintain God's house of prayer seriously.

"The gatekeepers had been assigned to their positions of trust... guarding the gates of the house of the Lord... Others were assigned to take care of the furnishings... Those who were musicians, heads of the Levite families, stayed in the rooms of the temple and were exempt from other duties because they were responsible for the work day and night (1 Ch. 9:22-33)."

#### Help us Build the House

Life is busy and it's easy to go through a whole week without stopping to encounter the Lord. Joining a team ensures time in prayer and worship in His presence each week. You do not have to sign up for a bunch of nights to be helpful, committing to just one set a week helps us to maintain what we have and continue to build. We started 10 years ago with just one person, one hour and we are now at 35 hours a week. We have people committed to night and day prayer from all over the city, from dozens of congregations and many denominations and backgrounds. We invite you to join this unified effort of Decatur House of Prayer crying out together as we build up the wall of intercession for our city. Luke 18:7-8
